



Religious Values and Filial Piety: The Short Story of the Shopper on Mother's Orders and the Relevance to Indonesian Language Learning

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ABSTRACT

This article, titled "Religious Values and Filial Piety in the Short Story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* and Its Relevance to Indonesian Language Learning," aims to describe the religious values and filial piety contained in Silawati's short story, while also analyzing its relevance to Indonesian language learning in elementary schools. The research object is the short story text *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*. The research population encompasses the entire content of the short story, with the sample consisting of excerpts of dialogue and narration containing religious values and filial piety toward parents. The research instrument is the researcher herself, aided by a data recording sheet. Data collection was conducted through intensive reading and systematic recording of relevant sections. Data analysis employed a qualitative descriptive method using content analysis, enabling a deep exploration of the meanings embedded in the text. The results revealed religious values such as trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude. Additionally, values of filial piety toward parents were identified, including obedience, a spirit of mutual aid, responsibility, and efforts to restore trust. These values hold strong relevance for integration into Indonesian language instruction, particularly in children's literary appreciation activities. Thus, this short story serves not only as language teaching material but also.

Nilai Keagamaan dan Bakti Anak: Cerpen *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* dan Relevansi Pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia

ABSTRAK

Artikel berjudul "Nilai Keagamaan dan Bakti kepada Orang Tua dalam Cerpen *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* dan Relevansinya terhadap Pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia" ini bertujuan untuk mendeskripsikan nilai-nilai keagamaan serta bakti kepada orang tua yang terkandung dalam cerpen karya Silawati, sekaligus menganalisis relevansinya terhadap pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia di sekolah dasar. Objek penelitian yaitu berupa teks cerpen *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*. Populasi penelitian mencakup seluruh isi teks cerpen, dengan sampel berupa kutipan dialog dan narasi yang mengandung nilai-nilai keagamaan dan bakti kepada orang tua. Instrumen penelitian adalah peneliti sendiri dengan bantuan lembar pencatatan data. Teknik pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui pembacaan intensif dan pencatatan sistematis terhadap bagian-bagian yang relevan. Analisis data menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif dengan pendekatan analisis isi (content analysis), sehingga mampu mengungkap makna yang terkandung dalam teks secara mendalam. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan adanya nilai keagamaan seperti amanah, kejujuran, dan rasa syukur. Selain itu, ditemukan pula nilai bakti kepada orang tua, meliputi ketaatan, sikap tolong-menolong, tanggung jawab, serta upaya memulihkan kepercayaan. Nilai-nilai tersebut memiliki relevansi yang kuat untuk diintegrasikan dalam pembelajaran Bahasa Indonesia, khususnya dalam kegiatan apresiasi sastra anak. Dengan demikian, cerpen ini tidak hanya berfungsi sebagai bahan ajar bahasa, tetapi juga sebagai media efektif dalam pembentukan karakter peserta didik di sekolah dasar.

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INTRODUCTION

Literature is an effective medium for conveying life values, including moral, social, and religious values. In an educational context, literature serves not only as entertainment but also as a means of character building for students. Literary works are the result of human creativity expressed in written or spoken form. Literary works are not merely entertainment but also provide insight and values for their readers (Elmustian & Jalil, 2015; Salwa et al., 2025; Juriati & Razak, 2023). Thus, the use of literary works in Indonesian language learning is crucial, not only for improving language skills but also for shaping students' character. However, in practice, Indonesian language learning in schools still tends to focus on the cognitive aspect, while exploring the values contained in literary works has not been optimally implemented. Short stories are a form of literature that presents a simple story event and conflict. Short stories are a type of literary work described in written form as a short, clear, and concise story or narrative. In fictional stories, the values contained in short stories can attract someone to read them (Sanjaya et al., 2021; Elmustian & Setiawati, 2025). The short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* by Silawati is a literary work that contains religious values and devotion to parents. These values are reflected in the main character, who demonstrates trustworthiness, honesty, responsibility, and obedience to her parents. This story is relevant to study because it raises simple, relatable issues yet contains profound moral messages.

The research questions are as follows: (1) What are the religious values contained in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*? (2) What is the value of devotion to parents contained in the short story? (3) How are these values relevant to Indonesian language learning?

The purpose of this study is to describe the religious values in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*, the value of devotion to parents, and analyze the relevance of these values to Indonesian language learning in schools. This research can

contribute to the development of teaching materials that are oriented not only toward cognitive aspects but also toward character development in students.

Religious values in Islamic education encompass three main aspects: faith, worship, and morals (El-Yunusi et al., 2024). Amanah (trustworthiness) is an important value in Islamic education, emphasizing trustworthiness, responsibility, and maintaining the trust placed in others (Buhori, 2018). Devotion to parents is a form of noble morality strongly emphasized in Islamic teachings (Sulaiman & Saepulloh, 2024). This value encompasses respect, obedience, and good behavior toward parents in all circumstances, as stated in Surah Al-Isra'a, verses 23–24 of the Quran.

Several previous studies discussing religious literature include those by Nurjaya (2021) and Disi & Hartati (2018). These studies tend to present moral values normatively without in-depth descriptions of the socio-religious context. No research has been found specifically examining the religious values and devotion to parents in Silawati's short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* and linking them to Indonesian language learning. Therefore, this research has novelty, namely integrating the analysis of religious values and devotion to parents in literary works with their relevance to Indonesian language learning.

METHOD

This study employed a qualitative approach with a descriptive-analytical approach. Qualitative research is descriptive in nature and tends to utilize an inductive approach to analysis (Dellia et al., 2025; Razak, 2017; Fraenkel et al., 2012). Qualitative research, on the other hand, does not utilize statistics but rather involves data collection, analysis, and interpretation. The qualitative approach was chosen because this study aims to deeply understand and describe the values contained in literary texts, particularly religious values and devotion to parents in short stories. The research focus is limited to analyzing the religious values and devotion to parents contained in the



short stories, as well as their relevance to Indonesian language learning in schools. The data in this study consist of words, phrases, sentences, dialogue, and narratives in the short stories that contain religious values and devotion to parents. Furthermore, this study also utilized references in the form of literary theory books and scientific journals.

This research design utilizes library research because the data used are derived from written texts relevant to the focus of the study. The scope or object of this research is the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* by Silawati. The research material is a short story text as the object of analysis, while the tools used are supporting instruments such as data recording guidelines (data cards) to group quotes according to value categories. The data collection technique used is the reading and note-taking technique. The steps include: (1) reading the short story in its entirety and repeatedly to gain a comprehensive understanding; (2) identifying parts of the text that contain religious values and devotion to parents; (3) recording the data found along with its context; and (4) grouping the data into predetermined categories. The data analysis technique used is content analysis. The analysis process is carried out through several stages, namely: (1) data reduction, by selecting data relevant to the research focus; (2) data classification, by grouping data into categories of religious values and devotion to parents; (3) data interpretation, by interpreting the meaning of these values in the context of the story; and (4) drawing conclusions, by formulating the overall research findings and relating them to Indonesian language learning.

RESULT

1. Religious Values in the Short Story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*

In the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* religious values are clearly evident through the behavior of the main character, who demonstrates trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude in carrying out the tasks assigned by his mother. Religious

values in Islamic education encompass three main aspects: faith, worship, and morals (El-Yunusi et al., 2024). These three aspects are interrelated in shaping individual character based on religious teachings.

2. The Value of Devotion to Parents in the Short Story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*

Devotion to parents is a form of noble morality that is highly emphasized in Islamic teachings. This value encompasses respect, obedience, and good behavior toward parents in all circumstances, as stated in Surah Al-Isra', verses 23–24 of the Quran. Devotion to parents is also an important indicator in the formation of a student's religious character. In the short story, the character's attitude of consciously helping his mother reflects the application of these values in everyday life. This behavior demonstrates that the value of devotion is not only understood theoretically but also embodied in concrete actions. Therefore, this short story can be used as an effective learning medium to instill the value of devotion to parents in children through a simple and easy-to-understand narrative.

3. Relevance to Indonesian Language Learning

The short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* by Silawati contains religious values and devotion to parents that are highly relevant for study in Indonesian language learning. The religious values in this short story are reflected in the trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude demonstrated by the main character in carrying out tasks assigned by her mother. Furthermore, the value of devotion to parents is seen through obedience, responsibility, mutual assistance, and the character's efforts to restore her mother's trust after making a mistake.

DISCUSSION

Religious Values in the Short Story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*

Understanding the integration of language, literature, and religion will enable the creation of a harmonious religious and social life that is diverse

(Maula & Mukhlis, 2025). In the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* religious values are clearly visible through the behavior of the main character, who demonstrates trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude in carrying out the tasks given by her mother. The character Margoletta is depicted as a child who tries to maintain her mother's trust when given money to shop for household needs. However, she experiences an inner conflict when tempted to use some of the money to buy snacks. This conflict is an important part of the story because it shows the moral learning process experienced by the character. In the end, Margoletta chooses to be honest by admitting her mistakes to her mother and showing remorse. An attitude of gratitude is also seen when she accepts the situation with an open heart and feels content with what she has. This shows that the short story not only presents a simple story, but also contains religious values that can be used as examples in everyday life.

Religious values in Islamic education encompass three main aspects: faith, worship, and morals (El-Yunusi et al., 2024). These three aspects are interrelated in shaping individual character based on religious teachings. In the context of the short story "The Shopper Asked by Mother" by Silawati, the most dominant value displayed is morals. This moral value is reflected in the trustworthiness demonstrated in maintaining trust, honesty in admitting mistakes, and gratitude for one's circumstances. These values are conveyed through a simple storyline that is close to children's daily lives. Thus, this short story can be an effective medium for instilling religious values in readers. Furthermore, the values conveyed are easy to understand and internalize because they are presented through the experiences of the characters in the story.

a. The Value of Trustworthiness

The value of trustworthiness in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* is reflected in the main character's efforts to maintain the trust placed in her by her mother. Margoletta is given the re-

sponsibility to pay for the household's needs with the money entrusted to her. During the process, he was tempted to use the money for personal gain. However, this experience served as a crucial lesson for him in understanding the meaning of trust. He realized that trust must be safeguarded responsibly. This is reinforced by the quote, "Letta, I entrusted that money to you. That's called trust. If trust isn't safeguarded, people can be disappointed." This quote emphasizes that trust is a form of trust that should not be misused. Thus, the value of trust in this short story teaches the importance of responsibility and trust in everyday life.

Trust is an important value in Islamic education, emphasizing trustworthiness, responsibility, and maintaining the trust placed in others (Buhori, 2018). The value of trust is closely related to faith because it reflects a person's moral quality in everyday life. Someone who is able to safeguard trust will demonstrate integrity and responsibility in every action. In the story, the character's efforts to restore his mother's trust reflect the practical application of the value of trust. This demonstrates that the value of trust is not merely theoretical but can be realized in everyday behavior. Therefore, this story can be used as a learning tool to instill the value of trustworthiness in children through concrete and easy-to-understand examples.

b. The Value of Honesty

The honesty demonstrated by the main character in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* is one of the important values ??conveyed in the story. Margoletta is depicted as having made a mistake by using some of her shopping money for snacks. This action could have been hidden, but she chose to tell the truth to her mother. This decision demonstrates courage in admitting her mistake. Furthermore, this attitude also reflects responsibility for her own actions. This is reinforced by the quote, "Mom... forgive Letta. Letta bought a little snack earlier." This quote demonstrates that honesty is a priority, even in difficult circumstances. Thus, the value of honesty in this short



story teaches the importance of telling the truth and having the courage to face the consequences of one's actions.

Honesty is an important value in education that serves to shape the character of individuals with integrity (Saeful, 2021). Honesty is related to the attitude of telling the truth, not lying, and not hiding the truth. This value needs to be instilled from an early age so that individuals become accustomed to being open and responsible. In the story, the character's action of admitting his mistake is a concrete example of the application of the value of honesty. This attitude demonstrates that honesty is not always easy, but must be practiced. Therefore, this story can be used as a learning tool to instill the value of honesty in children through the character's experiences that are close to everyday life.

c. The Value of Gratitude

The gratitude in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* is depicted through the main character's attitude of accepting her situation with complete sincerity. Margoletta not only learns from her mistakes but also realizes the importance of appreciating what she has. She understands that even though she cannot always fulfill her personal desires, there are still many things to be grateful for in her life. This attitude is evident when she feels satisfied with the food provided by her mother and no longer suppresses her desire to buy snacks. This change in attitude demonstrates the character's moral and emotional development. Therefore, the value of gratitude in this short story is reflected in the character's ability to accept her situation and appreciate the blessings she has received.

Gratitude is a positive emotion that arises when a person recognizes and appreciates the goodness or blessings received in her life (Listiyandini et al., 2016). Gratitude is not only related to feelings but is also reflected in daily attitudes and behavior. Individuals who experience gratitude tend to be more accepting of their circumstances and feel content with what they have. In this short story, the character's ability to accept

her situation and remain happy demonstrates the application of the value of gratitude. This is reinforced by the quote, "Margoletta felt happy to be able to help her mother, who was weak after giving birth." This quote demonstrates that happiness does not always come from personal pleasure, but also from helping others. Therefore, the gratitude in this story is reflected in the character's ability to appreciate her role within the family. Therefore, this story can be used as a learning tool to instill the value of gratitude in children in a contextual and easy-to-understand manner. The Value of Devotion to Parents in the Short Story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*.

The devotion to parents in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* is illustrated through the main character's behavior, who sincerely helps her mother with her daily needs. Margoletta is depicted as an obedient child who never complains when asked to shop. She understands her mother's frail condition after giving birth, which necessitates her assistance. This awareness drives her to fulfill her role responsibly. Furthermore, the character is also able to prioritize her mother's interests over her own desires, such as refraining from buying snacks. This demonstrates that devotion to parents is not only obedience, but also care and sacrifice. This attitude is reinforced by the quote, "From then on, Margoletta became Mother's shopping assistant almost every day. She never complained because she knew her mother still needed plenty of rest." This quote illustrates the character's sincerity in helping her parents. Thus, the value of devotion to parents in this short story is reflected through the concrete actions of the character in her daily life.

Devotion to parents is a form of noble morality that is highly emphasized in Islamic teachings (Sulaiman & Saepulloh, 2024). This value encompasses respect, obedience, and good behavior toward parents in all circumstances, as stated in Surah Al-Israa, verses 23–24 of the Quran. Devotion to parents is also an important indicator in the development of a student's religious character. In the short story, the character's conscious assistance

to her mother reflects the application of this value in everyday life. This behavior demonstrates that the value of devotion is not only understood theoretically but also manifested in concrete actions. Therefore, this short story can be used as an effective learning medium for instilling the value of devotion to parents in children through simple and easy-to-understand storytelling.

a. Obedience to Parents

Obedience to parents is a strong value in the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu*. This is evident in Margoletta's attitude, who always carries out her mother's orders without question. She helps her mother shop every day conscientiously, especially knowing her mother's weak condition after giving birth. The character's obedience is not accompanied by complaints, but rather is carried out sincerely and responsibly. This attitude demonstrates that the character is able to prioritize her obligations to her parents. This statement is reinforced by the quote, "From then on, Margoletta became Mother's shopper almost every day. She never complained because she knew her mother still needed a lot of rest." This quote confirms that the character's obedience is consistent and based on a sense of caring.

In Islamic studies, obedience to parents holds a crucial position. Devotion to parents is a commandment affirmed in the Quran and is part of the noble morals that every individual should possess (Jukhairin, 2023). Obedience to parents includes being obedient, respectful, and not arguing as long as the order does not conflict with religious teachings. This value also plays a role in fostering harmonious relationships within the family. In the short story, the character's behavior, who always carries out his mother's orders, reflects the practical application of these values. This demonstrates that obedience is not merely a concept but can be realized in everyday actions. Therefore, this short story can be used as an effective learning medium to instill the value of obedience to parents from an early age.

b. Responsibility

The value of responsibility in the short story "Businessman for Mother's Order" is reflected through the main character's willingness to help her mother meet her daily needs. Margoletta doesn't simply follow orders but also demonstrates sincerity in completing the assigned task. She strives to ensure that the money she brings is used according to the specified needs. Despite making mistakes, she doesn't shy away from her responsibilities but instead strives to correct them and perform her tasks better. This attitude demonstrates that responsibility doesn't just mean carrying out tasks but also having the courage to face the consequences of one's actions. Responsibility is an important value that must be instilled from an early age through habituation and parental guidance in daily life (Usman, 2017). The value of responsibility encompasses the awareness to carry out tasks well and the readiness to accept the consequences of one's actions. In the short story, the character's actions in helping her mother and correcting mistakes reflect the practical application of the value of responsibility. Therefore, this short story can be used as an effective learning tool to instill the value of responsibility in children through simple and easy-to-understand behavioral examples.

c. Mutual Assistance in the Family

The family life in the short story *"Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu"* demonstrates a mutually supportive relationship between children and parents. Margoletta is portrayed as a child who is sensitive to her mother's frail condition after giving birth. She not only waits for orders but also shows initiative in helping with household chores. This awareness stems from her care and affection for her mother. She is even willing to put aside her personal desires to carry out tasks she deems more important. This demonstrates that mutual assistance in the family can grow from self-awareness, not coercion.

Furthermore, the mutual assistance is also



evident in the characters' decisions about prioritizing. Margoletta chooses to continue fulfilling her responsibilities despite the temptation to do other, more enjoyable things. This is reinforced by the quote, "I can't. I have to go shopping for Mother," which demonstrates her commitment to helping the family. This attitude reflects that helping parents is not only an obligation but also a form of sacrifice and responsibility. In this situation, the characters are able to demonstrate maturity in their behavior. They understand that family interests must take precedence over personal interests. Thus, the value of helping each other in this short story can be seen from the real actions carried out by the characters in their daily lives.

Sharing and helping behaviors can develop through parents' role models and instilling habits from an early age (Khairunnisa & Fidesrinur, 2021). The family environment is the primary setting for children to learn about caring and cooperation. Children who are accustomed to seeing and engaging in mutual assistance will more easily internalize these values. This aligns with the behavior of the characters in the short story, who demonstrate caring for their mothers. The values of mutual assistance presented are not merely theoretical but also reflected in concrete actions. Therefore, this short story can be used as an effective learning medium to instill a spirit of mutual assistance within the family in children in a contextual and easily understood way.

In the short story "Businessman for Mother's Order," restoring trust is one form of devotion to parents demonstrated by the main character. After making a mistake by using shopping money, Margoletta does not dwell on guilt but strives to improve her attitude through concrete actions. She returns to carrying out her duties with greater care and strives to maintain the trust that had previously wavered. This change does not occur instantly, but rather through a process that demonstrates a commitment to self-improvement. This is evident in the quote, "Letta is now more trustworthy," which indicates that the character's ef-

forts are beginning to be recognized by her mother. In this context, devotion to parents is not only interpreted as obedience, but also as the ability to correct mistakes and maintain good relationships. Trust is closely linked to religious values, which emphasize the importance of honesty and responsibility in life (Go & Carm, 2017). Therefore, the restoration of trust in this story demonstrates that family relationships can be repaired through a sincere and consistent attitude of good deeds.

Relevance to Indonesian Language Learning

Comprehensive contextual learning involves a holistic approach that integrates academic knowledge with practical, relevant, and meaningful experiences for students, so that learning is not merely the transfer of knowledge but the ongoing construction of meaning (Nuranjani & Miladiyati, 2026). The short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* by Silawati contains religious values and devotion to parents that are highly relevant to study in Indonesian language learning. The religious values in this short story are reflected in the trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude demonstrated by the main character in carrying out her mother's duties. Furthermore, the value of devotion to parents is demonstrated through obedience, responsibility, mutual assistance, and the character's efforts to restore his mother's trust after making a mistake. These values are presented through a simple storyline, making it easy for readers, especially students, to understand. Thus, this short story serves not only as entertainment but also as an educational tool instilling moral and religious values.

The relevance of this short story to Indonesian language learning can be seen in its ability to support the development of language skills and character building in students. The use of literary works in Indonesian language learning in elementary schools can serve as a medium for reflection for students to understand the meaning of life, differences, and togetherness (Hatima, 2025). This short story can be used as teaching material for

reading comprehension activities, intrinsic element analysis, and the extraction of values contained in the text. Furthermore, students can be trained to express opinions, discuss, and write based on the experiences of the characters in the story. The religious values and devotion to parents contained in this short story also align with the goals of character education in Indonesian language learning. Therefore, using this short story in the learning process can help students not only understand the text but also internalize positive values in their daily lives.

The short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* not only contains religious values and devotion to parents but also has strong relevance in Indonesian language learning, particularly in literature. The values contained in short stories, such as trustworthiness, honesty, responsibility, and concern for parents, can serve as reflection material for students in understanding everyday life. Through reading and analyzing short stories, students not only learn to understand the text's content but also identify the moral values contained within it. Literary works play a crucial role in learning because they convey moral values relevant to students' lives (Julianto & Umami, 2022; Razak et al., 2025). The use of short stories in learning can also improve students' critical thinking skills and literary appreciation. Therefore, the short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* can be used as an effective learning medium to develop language skills while instilling character values in students.

CONCLUSION

The short story *Tukang Belanja Suruhan Ibu* by Silawati contains religious values including trustworthiness, honesty, and gratitude, reflected in the characters' behavior in carrying out their trust. Furthermore, the short story also includes the value of devotion to parents, manifested in obedience, responsibility, mutual assistance, and efforts to restore trust after mistakes. These values are not merely conceptual but are presented contextually through a storyline that is close to

everyday life. Therefore, the religious values and devotion to parents in this short story are relevant for integration into Indonesian language learning, particularly in literary appreciation lessons, as they can support the development of language skills and the formation of students' character.

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
